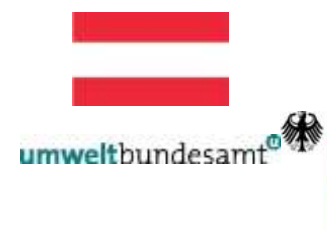

## Intention:

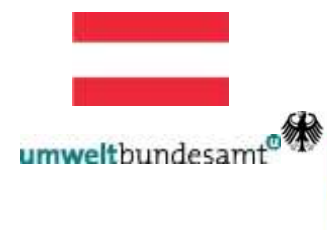
- Evaluate the daily problems at the local level

## Content:

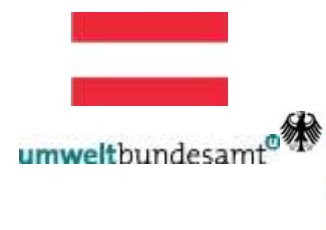

## Chapter 2: Guide for municipal waste permitting and inspection experts

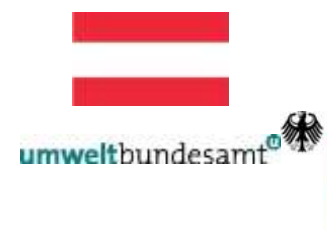
- Specification of hazardous waste, hazardous properties, limit values

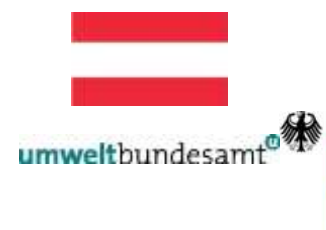
- Permitting, Inspections (check-list for waste inspection), Reporting rules

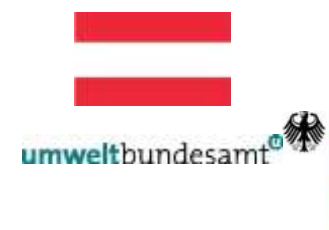
